

I call to your attention two planned activities of the Beautification Committee.

The first is the encouragement of all town residents, workers and businesses to celebrate Earth Day, Friday, April 22, 2005, by spending part of the day or following weekend picking up litter and debris from in front of their homes and around their business establishments. The litter remaining from the past difficult winter is particularly noticeable this spring. Norwell prides itself on being a litter free town and this town-wide cleanup day will have an immense beneficial impact upon the town's appearance.

The second activity celebrates Arbor Day, on Saturday, April 30, 2005, and involves the cutting back and removal of overgrown brush covering the stonewalls along both sides of Main Street between Lincoln Street and Homestead Farm Drive. The work will be done by committee members in cooperation with Bartlett Tree Service. Over the past several years the growth on these walls has reached the point whereby their appearance detracts from the beauty of Norwell and many residents have requested the work be done.

Each of these activities will promote the beauty of Norwell, enhance our quality of life and recognize the environmental awareness of our town.
