DISCUSSION:

ZBA Part-time Admin: Questions remain about how the new admin position will coordinate with the Board's current admin position about which there appears to be some confusion.

370 Washington Street Certificate of Occupancy: Members were informed that a CO has not been formally issued, according to the Building Office admin. She will check with the building inspector, who is currently on vacation. Members are concerned that all conditions contained in its decision must be met with landscaping plan compliance currently in question.

Bylaw Review Committee: A recently scheduled meeting was canceled due to lack of a quorum. The Committee will be continuing its review of the final recodification document from General Code to be presented to voters at the next Town Meeting. Committee members are still concerned that the changes contained in the 2012 Town Charter have not been incorporated into the Town's General Bylaw and will attempt to integrate those. The Committee has also discussed the need for special counsel to assist with that process, as well as the rewriting of certain sections of both bylaws.

<u>New Correspondence or Information Received</u>: 61 Accord Park Drive: New Application for Site Plan Modification rec. 6/25/18 – public hearing to be scheduled

<u>New Member Candidates</u>: The Board has received word that an application has been filed with the Selectmen's Office for a new member to be interviewed at a BoS meeting

in July. There could also be another candidate stepping forward in the near future, both of whom would be welcomed.
