Upon a motion duly made and seconded, Members Turner, Rivkind, and Greene VOTED to continue the hearing for the Special Permit/Section 6 Finding on property located at 354 Cross Street to October 17, 2018, at 7:25 P.M. Members made a preliminary finding that once the application to the Conservation Commission has been approved, panel members anticipate zoning approval will be routine in accordance with the plan submitted. Member Turner offered to draft a decision in advance of final approval.
