OLD BUSINESS/STATUS UPDATES:

- 495 Washington Street: The fence has been installed, but still waiting for gate. Hopefully, a final as-built plan can be submitted for review in the near future.
- 239 Washington Street 40B: The Board is awaiting an update from Town Counsel on the current status of the profits review by the state.
- 40 River Street 40B: Upon a motion duly made by Member Rivkind and seconded by Member Senteno, Members Rivkind, Senteno and Barbour VOTED to accept the As-Built Plans, reviewed by Chessia Consulting as being substantially in compliance with the approved plans. This item is now closed.

- **Simon Hill 40B**: The process for DEP Groundwater Permit is being followed in order for the Town's 30-day comment period to be known in a timely fashion.
- <u>15 High Street</u>: All files are now posted on the Board's webpage, and written public comments of neighbors will be added with email addresses redacted.
- **Zoning Articles**: Bylaw warrant article votes from the annual Town Meeting may not be properly sequenced for paper binders issued by General Code. Further work is needed to ensure these are correct.
