- * Main Street Pedestrian Improvement Project
 - Homestead Farm to Town Center

Glenn F. discussed the budget and believes the \$400K is enough to complete the next phase of construction. Glenn F. said he has purchased the granite curbing knowing there are shortages and he wants to be ready to start early Spring as it is too late to start construction now. Ilana Q. explained the grant process. The Town must spend the first 200K and then the State will re-imburse 200K for the second half of the project. Ilana Q. Confirmed that starting the project in early Spring 2023 gives Glenn F. and his crew plenty of time to complete the project before the December 2023 grant deadline.

Potential Projects / Grant Updates

Ilana Q. shared that in order for the Committee to be considered for future State funding a DOT 6 hour workshop that must be attended and a new Prioritization Plan must be formulated. Ilana Q. has agreed to attend the workshop and the Committee members will be thinking about what is next and plan to come to the next meeting with their 5 top priorities. Jason B. said he would be happy to announce that in the Spring we will be wrapping up the section to Town Center but suggested formalizing a plan prior to being added to the Select Board Meeting Agenda with next steps. Kristin F. (admin) shared the current Plan that is on the Complete Streets webpage and the Committee discussed completed projects on the list as well as items that have not been completed. Peter B. discussed the possibility of Survey Monkey to get a feel for what the townspeople would like to see happen next. Brendan S. was hoping to look at the potential of Vinal School and mentioned an existing path on Samuel Woodworth Road. Glenn F. felt that connecting Vinal School to the towns center was a very long stretch and was leery of how safe it would be but agreed access to schools and connecting to public transportation is important.
