
Complete Streets Committee Meeting Minutes

Selecting of potential locations:

Main St. Dover to Cross Street: Center of Town to Scituate line (1.7 miles)

Vinal School, Old Oaken Bucket, Central Street to, Summer Street (0.5 miles)

Grove Street existing sidewalk RT53-where it ends to Wompatuck Parking Lot on Grove Street

River Street – Gaffield to Hanover Town line

South Street High School to Hanover Town line / YMCA

Ilana Quirk recommended that the committee prioritize projects based on potential for grant money, which means emphasizing walkability, access to places immediately adjacent, smart growth projects.
