# Stetson Estates Preliminary Subdivision Plan

The applicant and executor, David Fox, appeared before the Board to answer questions about the project. As executor, he is required to maximize value of the property and they are currently exploring options to do this. The Board discussed the possibility of a common driveway serving three lots in addition to the waivers that would be required on a subdivision on the site. The Board will not make a determination on waivers without engineering.

### **Cushing Center Plan**

Member Etzel moved to approve up to \$5000 from the Pedestrian Enhancement Fund to pay for an electrical engineer subcontractor at the request of BETA group. The motion was approved 3-0.
