## Unaccepted Curbside Trash Items

In 1990, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) introduced its first bans on landfilling and combustion of easy-to-recycle and toxic materials. Additional "waste bans" have been phased in over time. The following materials and items are prohibited from disposal and/or transfer for disposal in Massachusetts:

- Asphalt Pavement, Brick & Concrete
- Cathode Ray Tubes\*
- Clean Gypsum Wallboard
- Ferrous & Non-Ferrous Metals\*
- Glass & Metal Containers
- Lead Acid Batteries\*
- Leaves & Yard Waste\*
- Recyclable Paper, Cardboard & Paperboard
- Single Resin Narrow-Necked Plastics
- Treated & Untreated Wood & Wood Waste
- White Goods (Large Appliances)\*
- Tires
- Mercury & Lithium Products\*

The Trash hauler enforces these items as they are on the State Waste Ban List. For more information on Waste Ban Materials please refer to MGL 310 CMR 19.017. \*Several items listed can be disposed of at the [Norwell Recycling Center](#) fees may apply.
