- Landscape and Fencing was on the December 6th Conservation Committee Agenda. Will Saunders talked about a damaged paver bay with minor fixable damage. As a result Will believes we should take time to look at option that wouldn't damage the bay or roadway and won't remove parking. The Conservation Commission did vote to install split rail fencing with chain in the location of Nation Grid access at the end of the parking lot.
