Discussion



1. Wompatuck Entrance & Parking Lot: Rich Claytor, P.E., was present for Horsley Witten; and Doug Luoma and Peter Williams were present for Friends of Wompatuck, (FOW). Member Sullivan presented the revised Plans, which included minor grading modifications to the trail head and terminus in order to achieve AAB-compliant grading, in response to recent guidance from the Architectural Access Board. All other aspects of the Plan remain unchanged; the walkway and parking, with an add-alternate for the boardwalk wetland crossing, which could be constructed by volunteers of the Friends of Wompatuck. The crossing would sit on crushed stone, 8" x 8" sleepers 30 inches above the wetland. The crossing was moved to the northern side of the National Grid easement, resulting in a shorter wetland crossing with reduced overall disturbance.

In response to a question from Member Lazzaro regarding the additional cost of compliant grading, Engineer Clayton estimated approximately \$10,000.00 to the earlier estimate of \$281,000.00, with a rounding to \$300,000.00 for the estimated construction cost estimate, with an available 344,000.00 budget. Member Sullivan also added in the \$125,000.00 CPC supplement, and felt they remained in great shape overall. Chair Cafferty went over the proposed bidding timeline, and requested setting the construction timeline as 120 days, instead of the usual 90 to account for material acquisition and setup.

Engineer Claytor mentioned the need to amend the Order or Conditions to reflect the modifications presented this evening. Commission Chair Wahl discussed the topic amongst the present Commissioners.

Motion by Chair Wahl and seconded by Commissioner Bjorlin to accept the minor modification as presented in the revised Plans by Horsley Witten. Unanimously voted 4-0-3 by a roll call vote.
